# Family Ups and Downs Genesis 33-36

#### I. Reunion with Esau - 33:1-16

- In one sense nothing has changed 1-3
   Esau still coming toward him with 400 men 1
   Jacob follows the plan he had made 2, 3
   But all has changed because God is in control
- 2. Esau runs to meet & warmly greet him 4-7
  He meets all of Jacob's family
- 3. Jacob insists on giving Esau his gift 8-11
- 4. Jacob declines Esau's offer 12-15
- 5. They go their separate ways 16-17 Esau returns to his home

### II. Jacob Settles in Canaan - 33:17-34:31

- Jacob settles in Succoth 33:17-20
   He pitched his tent toward the city 18
   He bought a parcel of land -19
   He erected an altar & worshipped God Called it "God, the God of Israel"
- 2. Daughter Dinah attracted to the city 34:1 Like Lot Jacob's choice will affect his family
- 3. She is sexually defiled by a man there 2
  He is a young prince named Shechem
- 4. He desires marriage with Dinah 3, 4
  Wants his father to arrange for this marriage
- Jacob heard but waited for sons return 5
   He remains silent
- 6. Shechem's father approaches Jacob 6 He tries to make a marriage agreement
- 7. Jacob's sons are very angry 7
- 8. The sons lay down a prerequisite 8-17 All the men of the city must be circumcised
- 9. Hamor presents to men of the city 18-24 Intermarriage can bring gain for us 23
- 10. After circumcision they are killed 25-29 Simeon & Levi slaughter all men of the city They take all the possessions of the city
- 11. Jacob's response to his sons 30-31 He realizes he can no longer stay in that place

### III. Back to Bethel - 35:1-15

- 1. God directs Jacob to return to Bethel 35:1 Place where God appeared & Jacob vowed
- 2. Going back means putting away idols 2-4
  Time to put away idols and be cleansed
  Time to rebuild the altar of the Lord
  His family & servants gave up all their idols
- 3. God protects them from retaliation 5, 6
  Fear of God kept people from pursuing them
- Jacob rebuilds God's altar at Bethel 7
   He renames it "the God of the house of God"

- 5. God appears to Jacob with a blessing 9-13
   He is finally back, out of Padanaram 9
   God reaffirms his new name is Israel 10
   God reaffirms His covenant promises 11
   God reaffirms His gift of the land to Jacob 12
- 6. Jacob builds memorial & worships 14,15 God is now truly Jacob's God

# IV. The Sorrows of Life - 35:16-29

- 1. Back with God, not exempt from sorrow Sorrow and death are a part of this life
- 2. Death of a beloved wife 16-20
  Rachel dies in childbirth Benjamin is born
- 3. Disgraceful act of Jacob's son 21, 22 Reuben has sex with his father's concubine
- 4. Jacob's sons are listed 23-26
  Listed with the mother who gave birth to them
- 5. Death of an aged father 27-29

  Jacob sees his father before he dies

### V. Generations of Esau - 36:1-43

- 1. Esau is son of Isaac, not forgotten by God
- 2. Esau intermarried with Canaanites 2
- 3. He left Canaan to separate from Jacob 6-9 He became the father of Edomites
- Esau's descendants will oppose Israel Amalek – 36:12 note Exodus 17:8-16 Edom opposed Israel's march to Canaan Numbers 20:14-21
  - Fought against Saul & David 1 Samuel 14:47; 1 Kings 11:15,16
