I. Relocation – Gen. 45:9-46:34

- 1. Joseph invites them to Egypt 9-13 Bring the family, we will provide for them
- 2. Joseph & brothers are reconciled 14-15
- 3. Pharaoh invites them to Egypt 16-24 Wagons are sent to transport the family
- Brothers report to their father 25-28 Joseph is alive, he wants us to come to Egypt
- 5. God confirms the move 46:1-4 I will there make you a great nation I will go with you into Egypt I will bring you back You will be reunited with Joseph
- You will be reunited with Joseph
- 6. Move revealed to Abraham 15:13-14
- 7. Jacob & his family move to Egypt 5-7 8. Sons listed with their families – 8-27
- Total of 66 made the journey to Egypt 26 With Joseph's family there were 70 - 27
- 9. Joseph is reunited with his father 28-30 Jacob's is fully satisfied seeing Joseph
- 10. Family is given land of Goshen 31-34 Choice pasture land for flocks and herds

II. Serving in Egypt – Gen. 47

- 1. Joseph's brothers meet Pharaoh -1-6 They are offered jobs with Egypt's herds
- 2. Jacob introduced to Pharaoh 7-10 Pronounces a blessing on Pharaoh
- 2. Joseph cares for his family 11–12
- 3. Joseph is faithful in his position 13-26 He fed the people of Egypt during the famine They paid for the grain as they were able With money – 13-14 With their animals – 15-17 With their lands & their lives – 18-21
- 4. Joseph cares for people's needs 22-26 He exempts the priests' land – 22 Gives seed for planting to Egyptians – 23-26
- 5. People of Israel prosper in Egypt 27
- 6. Joseph's promise to his father 28-31 After 17 years in Egypt, Jacob nears death He wants to be buried back with his family Joseph promises him that it will be done

III. Family Matters - Gen. 48

- Jacob reflects on God's grace 1-7 Reflection leads to thanks, worship – Heb. 11:21 Remembers God's covenant promise – 3-7 God has kept His word and even more Not only seen Joseph but his two sons
- 2. Adopts & blesses Joseph's sons 8-20 He blesses the younger over the elder
- 3. He looks forward in hope 21, 22 He talks of their return to the land of Israel He gives Joseph the double portion
