King's Ministry Begins Matthew 4

I. Tempted by Satan - 4:1-11

- Jesus is led by the Holy Spirit 1-2
 As a human He was led by the Spirit 1
 Led into the wilderness to be tempted by Satan
 Testing is to prove His commitment to God
 Test comes at a point of human weakness 2
 He had fasted 40 days & nights He was hungry
- Satan's first temptation 3-4
 Tempted to turn stones into bread
 Use divine power to serve personal need
 Jesus responds with Scripture Deuteronomy 8:3
 He is to act only as directed by God
- 3. Second temptation for Jesus 5-7
 Satan takes Him to pinnacle of Temple 5
 Challenges Him with Scripture 6 (Psa. 91:11-12)
 Jesus responds with Deuteronomy 6:16 7
 Trust God to meet need but don't test Him
- 4. Satan's third temptation 8-10 Offers world's kingdoms for His worship – 8-9 A legitimate offer based on 2 Corinthians 4:4 Satan is god of this world, desires worship Jesus rebukes him with Deut. 6:13; 10:20 Only God is worthy of worship & our service
- 5. Angels minister to Jesus 11
 With temptation over God provided for His needs

II. Ministry Begins in Galilee - 4:12-17

- From Judea, Jesus goes to Galilee 12
 Imprisonment of John sets time for this move
- 2. He also moves from Nazareth 13 Luke 2:16-30 records rejection in Nazareth
- 3. Capernaum new home in Galilee 13-16
 This is in fulfillment of Isaiah 9:1-2 and 42:6-7
- 4. He proclaims the Kingdom of Heaven 17The kingdom is "at Hand"There is a need of repentance

III. Response to His Ministry - 4:18-25

- Begins to gather disciples 18-22
 Peter & Andrew challenged to fish for men 18-20
 They left their nets to follow Jesus
 James & John respond to the challenge 21-22
 Left their ship and their father to follow Jesus
- 2. Ministry in Galilee synagogues 23

 There He proclaimed the "Gospel of Kingdom"
 He also healed all kinds of illness & diseases

3. His fame spread all over the region – 24-25 In Syria, Galilee, Decapolis, Jerusalem, Judea He healed many and cast out demons
