God's Timetable for Israel Daniel 9:24-27

I. 70 "Weeks" 9:24

- Daniel prays for restoration 9:1-19
 Confessing Israel's sin and guilt 3-16
 Asking God to restore for His name sake 17-19
- God responds to Daniel's prayer 20-23
 Sends Gabriel with a message for Israel
 Return in 70 yrs, but restoration would come later
- 3. Restoration not until 70 sevens 24 "weeks" (heptad) - group of seven - like our dozen We measure time in units of 10 (decades) Jews measured time in units of seven (heptads) Seven days in one week Seventh year is a Sabbath year Seven Sabbath years ushered in Year of Jubilee Seventy sevens would equal 490 Is it a week of 7 days, 7 months, 7 years? Time for rebuilding (seven sevens) fits years Dividing of week in v. 27 points to years 70 x 7 years would be 490 years

II. The Objectives - 9:24

- God plans full restoration
 This plan is for Daniel's people Israel
 And for Daniel's holy city Jerusalem
- 2. Full restoration includes the following: Finish the transgression - Israel's rebellion When Israel recognizes their Messiah Zechariah 12:10 Make an end of sins Messiah will put away all sins Make reconciliation for iniquity A sacrifice that will reconcile humans to God Bring in everlasting righteousness Righteousness will prevail forever Seal up vision and prophecy All of God's promises fulfilled in Christ Anoint the Most Holy Most Holy Place in Temple - Ezekiel 41-46 Or Most Holy One - Messiah the King Establishment of Messiah's kingdom
- All provided for in Christ's sacrifice
 But final restoration must await His return
 Israel will acknowledge their Messiah
 Zechariah 12:10; Romans 11:25-27
 Messiah will establish His kingdom
 Revelation 20:1-6
 God reigns in New Heaven & New Earth
 Rev. 21-22

III. The Outline - 9:25-27

- Begins with decree to rebuild 25
 sevens = 49 yrs rebuild Jerusalem, Temple
 Street and the wall rebuilt in troublous times
 Fulfilled in time of Ezra and Nehemiah
- 2. 62 sevens (434 years) until Messiah 25 Until Messiah is declared – Luke 19:28-40 Initiated by Jesus (His time had come) Must happen (stones would cry out – v. 40) Jews did not recognize their day – Lk. 19:41-44
- Messiah is cut off, rejected, crucified 26
 "Not for Himself" Not for any wrong in Him
 Offers Himself as Lamb of God Exodus 12:3
- 4. Interval of time indefinite length 26
 Begins with cutting off of Messiah, sacrifice for us
 Destruction of city and Temple 70 A.D.
 By people related to the prince who is to come
 Wars & desolations determined until last period
 Compare Matthew 24:4-8
 What was a definite time now is indefinite
 Matthew 24:36
- 5. 1 seven = 7 years Time of tribulation 27 Prince makes a covenant with Israel for 7 years This prince is yet to come (verse 26) Related to people who destroyed city & temple Part of same beast-like system Prince to come is the Antichrist May appear to resolve Mid-east crisis May allow Israel to rebuild their Temple Continue life under Mosaic Covenant, rejecting New Covenant
- 6. He will break his covenant after 3 1/2 yrs. He will stop all sacrifices in the Temple He will bring in an abomination causing desolation Jesus spoke of this in Matthew 24:15 Sign of beginning of Great Tribulation (3½ years) May be establishing his throne in the Temple 2 Thessalonians 2:3-4; Revelation 13:3-8 This awful condition will continue until end of the period

This prince, the desolator, will be destroyed Revelation 19:20

The 483 Years in the Jewish and Gregorian Calendars

Jewish Calendar (360 days per year)

 $(7 \times 7) + (62 \times 7)$ years = 483 years

483 years x 360 days 173,880 days Gregorian Calendar (365 days a year)

444 BC to AD 33 = 476 years

476 years <u>x 365 days</u> 173,740 days

- + 116 days in leap years
- + <u>24 days (March 5-March 30)</u> 173, 880 days

"decreed upon thy (Daniel's) people and upon thy holy city"
