The Great Disconnect Daniel 9:24-27

I. Plan for Restoration - 24

- Restoration not until 70 sevens 24
 "weeks" (heptad) group of seven like our dozen
 We measure time in units of 10 (decades)
 Jews measured time in units of seven (heptads)
- 2. This plan is for Daniel's people Israel And for Daniel's holy city Jerusalem
- 3. Full restoration includes the following: Finish the transgression - Israel's rebellion When Israel recognizes their Messiah Zechariah 12:10 Make an end of sins Messiah will put away all sins Make reconciliation for iniquity A sacrifice that will reconcile humans to God Bring in everlasting righteousness Righteousness will prevail forever Seal up vision and prophecy All of God's promises fulfilled in Christ Anoint the Most Holy Most Holy Place in Temple - Ezekiel 41-46 Or Most Holy One - Messiah the King Establishment of Messiah's kingdom
- 4. All looks forward to the Messiah Coming of Messiah is the focus of O.T.

II. Waiting for Messiah - 25

- Begins with decree to rebuild 25
 sevens = 49 yrs rebuild Jerusalem, Temple
 Street and the wall rebuilt in troublous times
 Fulfilled in time of Ezra and Nehemiah
 Returned to the land but not fully restored
- 62 sevens (434 years) until Messiah 25
 During this time Gentile rule continues
 First under Medes & Persians Book of Esther
 Next under Greece Antiochus & Maccabees
 Then under Roman rule
- 3. Promised Messiah comes as predicted 25

III. Why the Disconnect? - 26

- 1. Why is there a break in 70 heptads What significant event breaks the schedule?
- 2. Messiah is cut off 26 Jews reject Jesus as their Messiah Even though nothing is lacking in Him He fulfilled all of the Messianic prophecies Genealogy, place of birth. witness of John Ministry and miracles – sick, blind, lame, dead Cast out demons, forgave sin, walked on water Final sign – He rose from the dead

- He said the kingdom must await His return Matthew 24-25; Acts 1:6-11
- 3. Are objectives accomplished? 24 With rejection of Messiah is there restoration?

IV. Consequences of Rejection - 26

- Destruction of city and Temple 70 A.D.
 By people related to the prince who is to come Romans did this in 70 A.D.
 Wars & desolations determined until the end Compare Matthew 24:4-8
 What was a definite time now is indefinite Matthew 24:36
- 2. Words of Jesus in Luke 19:41-44

 If you had known that this was your day 42

 Things that belong to your peace Daniel 9:24

 But now they are hid from your eyes 42

 Blindness until end of time of Gentiles

 Romans 11:25
 - Destruction of Temple & Jerusalem Lk. 19:43-44 With it comes the scattering of the Jews
- 3. Testimony of Apostles Book of Acts Jewish rejection brings turn to Gentiles Paul sums it up at the end of the book Acts 28:25-29

V. Restoration of Israel - 27

- How will God bring about restoration
 There is 1 more heptad (7 years)
 One more time of trouble for Israel Dan. 12:1
 Greater than any Israel has experienced
- Prince comes with a plan for Israel 27
 Israel enters into a covenant with Him
 He has a plan for a Temple & sacrifices
 Jesus warned of false-messiahs (false-christs)
- 3. He breaks his covenant 3 ½ yrs. later Sacrifices cease when he desecrates the Temple
- 4. Jesus says this is a sign Matt. 24:15-24 It signals beginning of "Great Tribulation 21 In mercy God will shorten it to 3 ½ yrs.
- 5. Satan persecutes Israel Rev. 12:13-17 Beast makes war on them – Rev. 13:4-7
- 6. God preserves Israel in trouble Seals 144,000 from 12 tribes of Israel Sends 2 witnesses to minister to them
- 7. Messiah will destroy desolator 9:27 When He comes Israel will believe – Zech. 12:10 Israel will be saved (restored) – Rom. 11:25-36 God receives honor & glory for His grace
