I. Background for Galatians

- 1. Roman province in Asia Minor (Turkey)
- 2. Paul & Barnabas established Churches Derbe, Lystra, Iconium (Acts 14)
- 3. Jewish opposition against Paul's message At Iconium (Acts 14:2-5) At Lystra (Acts 14:19)
- 4. Judaizers undermined message of grace Said law & circumcision must be added
- 5. Paul writes to defend his apostleship And reaffirm the message of grace

II. Introduction - 1:1-5

- An apostle by God's appointment 1
 Christ & the Father chose him to be an apostle
 His apostleship was not by human appointment
 He had seen the risen Christ Acts 9:1-8
 Qualification for an apostle Acts 1:22
 Resurrection of Christ at heart of his ministry
- Fellow brethren send their greetings 2Stand with Paul in the message of grace
- 3. Grace & Peace from God through Christ 3
 Provision of grace establishes peace with God
 Resting in God's grace brings peace to us
- 4. Grace seen in Christ's redemptive work 4 Deliverance through Him who died for us He paid in full the penalty of our sins He delivers us from this present evil world God's grace transforms us from within – Romans 12:2

God's will is for sinners to be set free God's will is for man to live in fellowship with Him

5. Christ is worthy of all glory eternally – 5Work of grace brings glory to GodThis will be the theme of praise forever

III. Theme - 1:6-9

- Paul's concern for these churches 6
 They had so soon departed from Grace Being persuaded by another message
- There is no other gospel 7
 Any other gospel is a perversion
 Those proclaiming another trouble you
- 3. A curse pronounced on them 8-9
 Whether it be Paul or his associates
 An angel from heaven
 Or anyone with another message
 Let him be accursed
 Don't let anyone turn you from God's grace
 There is no alternative to message of grace.
- What is the "Gospel"
 Paul outlines it in 1 Corinthians 15:1-4
 Christ died for our sins, He was buried,

He rose again the third day
5. What is "another gospel"
Some were adding the law to grace
Some were adding circumcision (baptism)
Cannot add rites or ritual to God's grace
Some would add good works to grace
Works & grace cannot go together – Rom. 11:6
