## Understanding the Law Galatians 3:19-29

## I. Function of the Law - 3:19, 22

- It was given to help define sin 19
   Measured human behavior by God's holiness
   Made aware of need of atonement Rom.7:7
- 2. It was intended to be temporary 19
  Added "until" the "seed" should come
  One in fulfillment of promise (Jesus Christ)
- 3. A different kind of covenant 19-20
  Ordained by angels
  Psa.68:17; Heb. 2:2; Acts 7:53
  Given through a mediator Exodus 19
  Implying a 2 party covenant
  God's covenant with Abraham was unilateral
- Law not to replace covenant of promise God's law & His promise, not in conflict - 21 Don't even think that for a moment
- 5. Law not to give life or righteousness 21 Could not give life, no one could fully keep it Could not declare righteous, only condemn
- Purpose was to declare all sinners 22
   Established guilt, created need of a Savior
   Prepared way for promise of God in Christ
   Righteousness must come through faith

## II. Focus of the Law - 3:23-25

- Law pointed to new revelation 23
   Old Covenant pointed to future
   Sacrifices, priesthood, Temple; were types
   "kept" idea of under protective custody
   Aimed at what God would do in the future
- Focus of law pointed to Christ 24
   Like a schoolmaster, governess until Christ
   How we train children "do's and don'ts"
   It helped set limits, restrain effect of evil
   To bring to justification by faith in Christ
- Not needed when purpose is fulfilled 25
   Faith in Christ brings inner transformation
   God's Law is written on our heart
   Our spirit is regenerated New birth
   God's Spirit indwells to teach and enable

## III. Full Son-ship in Christ - 3:25-29

- Guardian not needed in maturity 25
   Freedom from restraint comes with maturity
- Believers are mature sons of God 26
   Faith in Christ makes us adult sons
   Why would we now go back under restraint
- 3. Spirit unites us with Christ 27
  This baptism described in 1 Cor. 12:12-13
  Being in Christ we share His position as sons
- 4. Son-ship is shared by all in Christ 28
  No more divisive distinctions in Christ
  No distinction between Jew & Gentile

- No distinction between Slave & Free No distinction between Male & Female All in Christ share position as adult sons We are all one in Christ.
- 5. All in Christ are Abraham's seed 29 Since Christ is Abraham's seed (v.16) All who are in Christ are Abraham's seed
- 6. Now heirs to Abraham's promise 29 God's blessings enjoyed by those in Christ Now God's chosen people – 1 Pet. 2:9-10
