### Fear Not; See God's Salvation Exodus 12 - 14

## I. Led by God - 13:17-14:4

- Led by God into Wilderness 13:17-22 God chose the route for them - 17-19 Didn't choose most direct route Knew they were not ready for battle They took Joseph's bones with them – 19 As requested by Joseph – Genesis 50:25
- 2. Led by a cloud and fire 21-22 God's presence was visible day and night
- 3. Pursued by Pharaoh & his army 14:1-12 People fear, question God's leadership - 10-12

## II. Pursued by Pharaoh – 14:1-12

- 1. God's warning to Moses 14:1-4 Pharaoh's will come to recapture you God will prove His power to the Egyptians
- 2. Pharaoh gathers his army 14:5-9 Realizes he has lost his slaves – 5 Gathers 600 chariots and men – 6-7 They pursue Israel to the Red Sea – 8-9
- 3. Israel cries out in fear 14:10-12 They cry out to God & complain to Moses

## III. God's Deliverance – 14:13-31

- 1. Moses stills the people 13-14 Stand still & watch what God will do He will destroy the Egyptian army He will fight for you
- 2. Moses is directed by God 15-18 Tell Israel to go forward – 15 Lift up your rod over the sea – 16 Sea will part & people can walk on dry ground God will harden Egyptians hearts – 17-18 They will follow to their death in the Sea
- Israel is protected by God 19-20
   Angel of the Lord protected from Egyptians
   Stood between Israel and Egyptians

   Presence of God was there to protect
   God's cloud was darkness to Egyptians
   It was light to the Israelites
- 4. God rolled back the Red Sea 21-22 Israel went through on dry ground
- 5. Egyptians perished in the sea 23-31
  They presumed they could follow Israel 23
  God troubled their journey 24-25
  Took off their chariot wheels
  Egyptians decided to flee back to shore
  God destroyed Egyptians in the Sea 26-28
- 6. Israel went through on dry ground -29-31

# IV. Song of the Redeemed - 15:1-21

- Praise God for Deliverance 15:1-6
- 1. God destroyed their enemy in the sea 1

- 2. All glory belongs to God He did it He triumphed gloriously - 1 He is my strength, song, salvation - My God - 2 He is a man of war - 3
- 3. The power of the enemy has been broken 4,5 Overwhelmed in the sea, covered, sank to the bottom
- 4. The power of God is supreme 6 Your right hand is glorious, all powerful

### Praise God for His Excellency- 7-11

- 1. God's power pitted against Pharaoh's gods
- God not only defeated, He annihilated them Overthrew those who rose up against Him - 7 Consumed them as stubble - 7 By blast of His nostrils He blew waters away - 8 When Egyptians presumed to go through the sea, God blew & waters returned to engulf them - 9-10
- 3. There is no one who can compare with God In the majesty of His person In the might of His power

### Praise God for His Impact - 12-16

 What God did to His enemies & what He did for His people will be a testimony to others They will hear how God swallowed up Egyptians - 12

They will hear how God led His people - 13 Fear & sorrow will grip their hearts - 14 People of Canaan will hesitate to fight against Israel's God - 15,16 (cp. Josh. 2:9-11)

2. No one can stand in the way of God and what He has determined to do for His people God's Redeemed people are under His care

### Praise God for Glorious Future- 17-19

- He will complete His work as promised-17-18
   He will bring His people into Promised Land 17
   He will plant them in His holy mountain
   He will establish His own Sanctuary there
   He will reign over His people forever 18
- 2. What God has done guarantees what He will do 19
- His present display of power assures us for the future
