10 Commandments form basis for God's law Give us principles that need to be applied Honor parental authority Respect human life as God-given Respect personal property of others Regard the reputation of others Restrain your desires for things Principles are applied by God in specific cases in the chapters that follow

I. Respecting Human Life - 21-1-17

- Caring for servants 21:1-11
 Poverty may bring servitude, limit 6 yrs 1-4
 Perpetual servitude is a personal choice
 Motivated by love 5-6
 Protection given to female servants 7-11
- 2. Capital Crimes against humans 21:12-17 Premeditated murder - 12-14 Provision made for manslaughter Physical abuse of parents - 15 Kidnapping - 16 Verbal abuse of parents - 17

II. Personal Injury Liability - 21:18-36

- 1. Injury in fighting 18-19 Pay loss time & medical expenses
- 2. Abuse of servant 20-21,26-27 Appropriately punished
- 3. Injury to Mother with child 22-25 Judges determine penalty
- 4. Caused by animal 28-32 Owner is responsible
- 5. Carelessness, negligence 33-36 Restitution for loss

III. Property Loss Liability - 22:1-15

- Stealing 1-4
 Thief is to make restitution
 Limited right to protect property 2-3
 Some cases restitution is double 4
- 2. Loss by carelessness, neglect 5-6 Loss is to be repaid
- 3. Things entrusted for safe keeping 7-13 Restitution when there is negligence
- 4. Responsibility for things borrowed 14-15

IV. Crimes against Humanity- 22:16-20

- 1. Sexual seduction 16-17 Responsible for actions Protection for a virgin
- 2. Witchcraft, sorcery 18 Punishable by death
- 3. Sexual relations with an animal 19

Death penalty

4. Idolatry - 20 Also a capital crime

V. Godly Character – 22:21-31

- 1. Show mercy to the Needy 22:21-27 Care for the stranger - 21 Don't oppress the widow or orphan - 22-24 Be gracious to the poor - 25-27
- 2. Honor & Respect all authority 22:28-31 Judges, rulers and God Himself
