- 2. System set for dividing land 52-56 Larger tribes will receive a larger portion - 54 Land divided by lot - God will decide - 55-56
- 3. Levites numbered to serve God 57-65
- 4. Portion for families with no sons 27:1-11 Daughters inherit but must marry in own tribe
- 5. Moses successor appointed 12-23 Moses will see land but not enter it - 12-14 Joshua will be the new leader - 15-23

II. Preparing for Worship - 28-30

1. New generation learns to worship – 28-29 The Daily offerings - 28:1-8 The offerings on the Sabbath - 9-10 Offerings for a New Month - 11-15 Annual Celebrations - 28:16-29:40 Passover, Unleavened bread - 16-25 Feast of Weeks - 26-31 Feast of Trumpets - the New Year - 29:1-6 The Day of Atonement - 7-11 Feast of Tabernacles - 12-40

2. Vows must be kept as sacred - 30 Husbands & fathers responsible for families

III. Preparing for Warfare - 31-32

- 1. Israel must deal with Midianites 31 Moses must finish matter before he dies - 2 Spared women who caused Israel to sin - 14-17 Israel learns lessons for future battles - 18-54 Regulations set for distributing spoils of war
- 2. All must fight for Land of Canaan 32 Includes Reuben, Gad, 1/2 Manasseh Desired land east of Jordan - 1-5 Must fight with other tribes- 6-15 They agree to Moses' terms - 16-32 Moses gives them their inheritance - 33-42

Plan for possessing land 33:50-36:13 Drive out Canaanites completely - 33:50-56 Boundaries set for their new land - 34:1-15 Elders are to supervise allotments - 16-29 Tribe of Levi to have cities with tribes - 35:1-5 Six cities are to be Cities of Refuge - 6-34 Refuge was provided only for manslaughter Inquest to determine if it was manslaughter Murderers must be put to death Families with no sons get inheritance - 36:1-13
