

The Lordship of Jesus Christ Luke 6

I. Lord of the Sabbath – 6:1-11

1. God established Sabbath in the law
Set aside as a day of rest for humans & animals
2. Religious leaders added their traditions
Setting don't other restrictions
3. Disciples picked grain on Sabbath – 1
Separated grain from husks by rubbing in hands
4. Pharisees accused them of violation – 2
Working – threshing grain on the Sabbath
5. Jesus gave the true interpretation – 3-5
God's law always allowed for meeting needs
6. Luke adds a second example – 6-11
Healing a man with a withered hand
7. Another Sabbath Jesus is teaching – 6
A man was there with withered right hand
8. Leaders are looking to accuse Him – 7
Will He violate the Sabbath?
9. Knowing their thoughts He acted – 8
He had the man to stand up
10. He asked the leaders a question – 9
Is it lawful to do good on the Sabbath?
11. With no answer He healed the man – 10
12. Angry, they plotted against Jesus - 11

II. Lord Chooses Disciples – 6:12-19

1. Spent the night in prayer – 12
Choosing men who would continue His ministry
God's will led to choosing a traitor
2. 12 chosen to be His apostles – 13
Disciples (trainees) to be Apostles (sent ones)
3. Men were linked naturally – 14-16
Peter & his brother Andrew
James & his brother John
Philip & Bartholomew
Matthew & Thomas
James son of Alphaeus – distinguish from James
Simon called Zelotes – distinguish from Peter
Judas of (son of) James – another Judas
Judas Iscariot – the traitor
4. Jesus resumed His ministry – 17-19
Came with His 12 disciples to multitude
They gathered to hear Him & be healed
Jesus healed diseases & cast out demons

III. Lord Teaches with Authority – 20-49

1. Path to blessing – 20-23
Humble - ready to learn – 20
Needy - open to ministry – 21
Seeking God's approval not man's – 22-23
2. Woe to those who miss this path – 24-26
Rich – self-sufficient – 24
Full – don't need help – 25
Approved by men – 26

3. Disciples reflect Master's heart – 27-38
Loving, gracious spirit even to enemies – 27-31
Lord's love is uncommon love – 32-35
Reflecting God's mercy – 36-38
4. The Disciple's consistency – 39-49
A leader must see clearly to lead – 39-40
He must be free of hypocrisy – 41-42
His life bears good fruit – 43-45
Lordship means obedience – 46
God's truth must be applied – 47-49
