## Missing the Mark Luke 13

## I. Accountability is Inevitable – 13:1-5

- Some die because of human cruelty 1-3
   Don't judge them to be greater sinners
- 2. All will perish unless they repent All are guilty and accountable to God
- 3. Some die in natural catastrophes 4-5 Don't judge them to be greater sinners
- 4. Unless you repent you will perish All are accountable before God

#### II. God is Gracious - 13:6-9

- Sin is not always judged immediately 6-7
   Parable of fruitless fig tree
   Did not produce any figs
   Owner waited three years & ordered it cut down
   Worker asked for another year to work
   He would dig around it and fertilize it
   If it still did not produce cut it down
- 2. Without repentance sin must be judged Don't misjudge the grace of God

# III. Misjudging God's Mercy - 10-17

- Jesus is teaching in a synagogue 10
   On the Sabbath He goes to the synagogue
- 2. Woman with infirmity for 18 years 11 Bent over unable to stand erect
- 3. Jesus healed her infirmity 12-13
  Able to stand erect she glorified God
- 4. Ruler in anger chastised Jesus 14
  Six days for you to work not on Sabbath
- 5. Jesus spoke of God's mercy 15-16 Law permits deeds of mercy on Sabbath

#### IV. Misjudging God's Kingdom - 18-21

- Don't reject Kingdom in seed form 18-19
   There is great potential in a seed
   Mustard seed grows into a large plant
   To accept seed form requires faith
- 2. Leaven also demonstrates this truth 20-21 Small amount of yeast has big impact Don't miss God's work when it looks small

### V. Misjudging Privilege - 22-30

- Cities where Jesus ministered 22-23
   Thought that gave them entrance to Kingdom Few, only privileged will get in
- 2. Access is by same gate for all 24 If you don't enter the gate you will not get in
- 3. Must enter while gate is open 25
- 4. Pleas of privilege go unanswered 26-27 I don't know you rejection brings judgment
- 5. Others enter you will be left out 28-30 Some you put last will be first

## VI. Fearing Human Authority - 31-33

- 1. Pharisees warn of Herod's power 31 Flee because Herod will kill you
- Jesus is committed to His mission 32-33
   His ministry must continue
   It will end in God's time and in Jerusalem

## VII. Tragedy of Missing out - 34-35

- Jesus grieved over Israel's loss
   Israel the privileged nation, Jerusalem the city
   Like their fathers reject God's message
- 2. Jesus said "I would gather you"
  As a mother hen gathers her chicks
  Under her wings as the place of safety
- 3. But they would not It was their choice that shut them out
- 4. Jerusalem is left in desolation Until the Lord returns
