- I. God Calls Joshua to Lead 1:1-2
- 1. Moses is dead Time to move on under new leadership Cannot enter the land until Moses dies Numbers 20:12
- 2. Joshua's preparation 1:1 "Moses' minister"
- He faithfully served under Moses Led Israel in conflict with Amalek – Ex. 17:8-16 Went with Moses up Mt. Sinai – Ex. 24:13 Was with Moses when God spoke – Ex. 33:11 Was a spy at Kadesh-barnea – Num. 13:8, 16 Chosen by God to lead – Num. 27:18-23
- 3. Joshua challenged to assume leadership Moses is dead but no change with God His plan had not changed – 1:2 – cp. Ex. 3:7-8 His promises are the same – 1:3 Joshua to lead into Promised Land
- 4. Leaders change but God does not Human leadership is not the key issue

II. God Pledges His Support - 1:3-5

- They will be victorious 3-5 God is committed to His people His power remains
 "Wherever you step, I will give you"
 "No enemy will be able to stand against you"
- 2. God will be with Joshua 5
 God promised success and His presence
 "As I was with Moses, so I will be with you:"
 "I will not fail you nor forsake you."
 Moses may be dead but God is still alive

III. God Calls him to Courage - 6-9

- 1. Joshua will need strength & courage 6 God fulfills His promise but with challenges
- Courage needed to obey God 7
 Don't deviate from what God said
 Success promised as we obey His Word
- 3. Obedience requires time in God's Word 8 Meditate – study it over so you can obey
- Trust & Obedience delivers from fear 9 God will be with you wherever you go

IV. God leads into Action – 10-18

- Joshua & leaders challenge people 10-15 They solicit the support of all the people God desires unity on the part of His people That includes the tribes on the east of Jordan
- 2. Unity based on commitment to same Lord Unity built upon allegiance to His Word Bound together determined to obey God
- 3. People respond to Joshua 16-18
