# David's Legacy 2 Samuel 24; 1Chronicles 21-28

## I. A Site for the Temple - 24

- God is angry with Israel 24:1 &
   As with Job He allows Satan to test David
   1 Chron. 21:1
   David tells Joab to number the people 2
   From number given it is the men of war age 9
   Joab protests to David 3
   God is able to add to the number of men
   But David prevails and Joab numbers 4-8
   Over 9 months & 20 days he covers the land
- Joab reports back to David 9
  2. David is convicted & confesses his sin 10
  Perhaps it was a matter of pride for David
- 3. Gad delivered God's message 11-13
  David can choose 1 of 3 punishments
  7 years of famine
  3 months fleeing from your enemies
  3 days of pestilence in the land
- 4. David chooses 3 days of pestilence 14
  He knows God is merciful so he chooses this
- 5. Pestilence came on Israel 15-1670,000 died in IsraelAs Angel came to Jerusalem God stopped him
- 6. David spoke to God taking the blame 17
- 7. Gad told him set up an altar to God 18
  At spot where the angel stopped
  At the threshing floor of Araunah
- 8. David bought the land & worshipped 19-25
  Araunah offered it to David as a gift
  David refused as he insisted on buying it
  He will not offer to God what cost him nothing
- 9. 1 Chron. 21:28-22:1 offers more on this
   David changes the place of worship
   This is now the House of God 1 Chron. 22:1
   This is also Mt. Moriah 2 Chron. 3:1; Gen. 22:1
   God brings good out of this numbering

#### II. Preparing for the Temple - 1 Chron. 22 1

- 1. Stockpiling materials 22:2-4
  Gathered masons to prepare stones 2
  Prepared metals for building 3
  Iron for nails & gates, brass in abundance
  Cedar trees from Tyre in abundance 4
- 2. Prepared for materials before his death 5
- 3. Charged Solomon with building 6-13
- 4. Told Solomon all he prepared 14-16
- 5. Charged princes to help Solomon 17-19

## III. Organizing for Worship - 23-24

1. Levites divided for service – 23:3-5
24,000 to serve in Temple by course – 3-4
6,000 to serve as officers & judges – 4
4,000 to serve as gatekeepers – 5

- 4,000 to serve as musicians 5
- 2. Priests are set in 24 orders 24:1-6 When they were to serve as priests

## IV. Plans for the Temple – 28:11-19

- David received plans from God 11-12
   Holy Spirit revealed these to David 12, 19
   Vestibule of the temple, its upper rooms, inner rooms, room for the mercy seat, courtyards, chambers and treasuries for dedicated things
- 2. Courses of Priests and Levites 13
- 3. Gold & silver for all the vessels 14-18 Instruction by weight
