# The Ram & the Goat Daniel 8

### I. The Vision of Daniel - 8:1,2

- In 3rd year of Belshazzar's reign 1
   Two years after his dream of 4 beasts
- In Shushan, capital of Persia 2
   Before Belshazzar's reign came to an end
   Vision puts Daniel in capital of Persia
- 3. Focused on two kingdoms in conflict
  One described as a ram, other as a goat
- 4. God warns His people of impact of this Goat will defeat the ram, change for Israel Time of great trouble will come to Israel Vision looks ahead some 375 years later

#### II. The Ram and the Goat - 8:3-8

- Ram with 2 horns is an empire 3-4
   Identified as Media & Persia 20
   Higher horn (Persia) comes up last
   Kingdom conquers other nations
   Pushes westward, northward & southward
- Western Goat defeats the Ram 5-8
   Goat is Greece, horn is Alexander the great 21
   Goat conquers with great speed 5
   Moves so fast its feet doesn't touch the ground
   Goat conquers with fury 6
   Angry from previous loses
   Battle of Marathon (490 B.C.) Salamis (481
   B.C.)

Goat defeats ram & stomps upon him - 7 Under Alexander becomes great empire - 8

3. Goat's great horn is broken - 8
Alexander conquers but soon dies (age 32)
Kingdom is divided into 4 parts
4 generals divide kingdom
Ptolemy was given Egypt
Cassander was given Macedonia & Greece
Lysimachus was given Trace & Asia Minor
Seleucus was given Syria, Israel & Mesopotamia

#### III. The Little Horn - 8:9-14

- Little horn comes from one division 9
   He becomes great & moves against others
   Toward the south, east & the pleasant land
   The Pleasant land refers to Israel
- 2. Horn is Antiochus Epiphanes
  Epiphanes means "The Magnificent one"
  Tried to Hellenize the Jews
  Required Greek language and culture
  Tried to destroy their worship
  Desecrated temple by offering sow's blood
  Persecuted the Jews

- Killed 40,000 in 3 days, took 10,000 as slaves
- 3. Assumed priesthood over Israel 10-12
  Removed some priests from office 10
  Set himself up as High Priest 11
  Daily sacrifices were taken away 11
  Set up Zeus (Greek god) in Temple 12
  Offered sow upon the altar
- 4. Length of Temple desecration 13-14
   For 2300 mornings & evenings- 14
   That is 1150 days (from 168 BC to 165 BC)
   Then Sanctuary would be cleansed 14
   Maccabees would lead in defeating Antiochus

## IV. Interpretation of Vision - 8:15-27

- 1. Gabriel is God's messenger 15-19 Vision will affect Israel in a later time
- 2. Ram & Goat are Identified 20-21
   Ram is kings of Media and Persia 20
   Rough goat is Greece, horn is first king 21
- 3. Alexander's empire divided in 4 parts 22
- Fierce king will come later 23
   Identified as Antiochus Epiphanes
- 5. He will have a great impact on Israel 24-27 He will exercise Satanic power over Israel - 25 He will destroy many Jews He will desecrate the Temple
- 6. He will be broken by power of God 25 He dared to challenge Almighty God
- 7. Daniel is to leave the vision sealed 26 It is for a future time, not Daniel's time
- 8. He is devastated by future for Israel 27
  But he continued to do the king's business
