## Reality of Fear 1 Samuel 21-23

## I. David Faces Fear - 21:1-15

- 1. He realizes the threat is real
  He is God's man but he is a real man
- He seeks help from the priest 1-3
   He is less than honest about his mission
   Fear can make a man desperate
   Lying is justified when one is desperate
- Priest gave him food for his men 4-6
   Only bread available is hallowed bread
   Bread is to be eaten by priests after offered
- God lets him experience consequences 7
   David is seen by Doeg, a servant of Saul 7
   David's actions later puts priests in jeopardy
- David is given Goliath's sword 8-9
   Seeks a weapon to defend himself
- 6. David seeks refuge with enemy 10-15
  His fear takes him to Gath 10
  Gath is the city of Goliath 17:4
  Discovered he pretends insanity 11-15
  Fear can cause us to act irrationally
  Discovery only increases his fear 11-12
  He pretends insanity in order to escape 13-15
  Note; "He changed his behavior" 18:14, 30
  Achish dismisses him

## II. God Relieves David's Fear - 22

- Surrounds him with band of men 1-2
   Family members join in support of David
   Others join him making a group of 400
- 2. Provides a refuge for his parents 3-4 King of Moab agrees t protect them
- 3. Follows God's directive from prophet 5
- 4. Saul warns his men of helping David 6-8
- 5. Doeg reports to Saul of the priests 9-10

  They gave him food, a sword & God's directive
- 6. Saul holds High Priest accountable 11-13 Charges him with helping David
- 7. High Priest denies the charges 14-15
  David is faithful servant on mission for King
  He did not enquire God for David
  He knew nothing of any rebellion in David
- 8. Saul orders execution of 85 priests 16-19 With them also everything in their city 19
- One priest escaped & fled to David 20-22
   He reports the slaughter of the priests
   David feels responsible for what has happened
- 10. David asks Abiathar to join him 23

## III. David seeks God's Direction - 23

- Seeks God's direction in warfare 23:1-5 God's directive deals with problem of fear David & his men defeat the Philistines
- 2. Seeks direction as he flees Saul 6-14

- God continues to answer David & delivers him
- David encouraged by Jonathan 15-18
   He rehearses their covenant
   He looks forward to serving King David
- 4. God intervenes to spare David 19-29 Saul gets information of David's location – 19-24 But when they got there David had moved Saul learned of David's new location – 25-26 His forces have David's men surrounded God intervened with Philistine invasion – 27-29 David moves on to a new refuge in En-gedi
