We look forward to having your child join us. Here's some helpful information about T&T.

Getting on Board

All new clubbers begin with the Start Zone. This involves passing seven sections and memorizing several key Bible verses. Passing the Start Zone makes your child eligible to become an official member of the club and receive a handbook and uniform.

Handbooks

The T&T handbooks answer questions about God and the Bible, guiding your child through this pivotal life stage to grow in Christ's grace. As your child works through their handbook, we hope you will encourage them. Handbooks involve memorizing Bible passages and making practical applications.

Uniforms

Uniforms give clubbers a place to display their handbook awards. A green jersey is the uniform for third and fourth graders. A blue jersey is the uniform for fifth and sixth graders. A uniform will be given to your child once they are eligible. If your child's uniform size is not in stock the night they become eligible, we will order one. Orders may take two weeks.

Awards

Children are awarded patches for each handbook discovery they pass. Those who complete a book during the year receive an award at the end of the year, and become eligible for our special end-of-year trip (horseback riding, canoeing, etc.).

Store

Clubbers receive one Awana Buck per section completed. Bucks may also be earned for various contests throughout the year. Each month there is a store where clubbers may spend their bucks on toys, snacks, electronics and more.

Bible Quizzing

To be eligible for our special Bible Quizzing event, clubbers need to pass the first four discoveries of their handbooks by the end of January.

Calendar

We meet on Wednesday evenings from 6:55 to 8:30 p.m. Please arrive a little early to get checked in. The club calendar is posted on our church website: linworthbaptist.org. Please refer to our church website for information about weather cancellations.

Cost

The cost is \$10 per child. This includes a handbook, uniform, badges and awards. Backpacks are available for a fee. Replacement items are available for purchase as needed. We hope this will keep Awana affordable and allow as many families to participate as possible. If cost is still a concern, please speak to one of the leaders about scholarships that are available.
