The Book of Revelation Unveiling The Victorious Christ Revelation 1:1-20

I. God's Final Message to Man

- 1. God's story begins in Genesis, How does it end? Satan doesn't want us to see how it ends
- Our Lord's final message to His Church 1:1, 2 Father gave this message to His Son, Jesus Jesus revealed it to His servants – Church (1:4) Lord wants us to know what will happen – 1:1 John testifies to what God and Christ said - 1:1, 2
- 3. God's blessing for all who read this book 1:3 This Book is not to be avoided, it brings blessing We are urged to pay attention to this message God wants us to know what is in His plan This message is to impact our lives, it is practical The blessing is for those who "keep" these words We need to develop an eternal value system We need to let this Book effect our lives "The time is at hand"

The things in this Book have significance for us Sense of urgency – "The time is at hand"

II. Recipients of the Message - 1:1,4

- 1. Jesus gave the message to John 1:1-2
- John wrote it down & sent it to 7 churches 4
 7 churches located in Roman province of Asia
 - This province is now in western Turkey These churches existed in times of persecution This message is to comfort and encourage them Actual churches but also representative What Christ says He says to all churches – 2:7 John directs attention to the Lord upon the throne
 - Grace and peace comes from Him Spirit enables us to face whatever situation

III. Doxology of Praise – 1:5-8

Revelation is filled with worship from the outset

- Jesus Christ is central focus of worship 5, 6 He is Faithful witness, Victor over death Prince who is worthy to rule over kings of earth Loves us & loosed us from our sins by His blood Made us a kingdom of priests unto God, Father He is worthy of all glory & to rule with all dominion
- Glorious triumph of Christ is also central 7, 8 Assures churches of ultimate victory in Christ. Christ is coming back, world will see Him in glory He will judge them and rule over this creation He started it all and will bring it all to conclusion He is Eternal Almighty God and He will triumph

IV. Introduction to the Vision – 1:9-11

1. John on the Isle of Patmos – 1:9 He is their brother & companion in tribulation Patmos was a Roman penal colony Also companion in Kingdom & patience of Christ His crime – For God's Word & witness of Christ

- John is in the Spirit on the Lord's Day 1:10 It is Sunday and He is worshipping "in the Spirit"
- 3. He hears a voice & sees a vision of Christ 11 Trumpet like voice gets attention – Ex. 19:16,19 Speaker identifies Himself as Alpha and Omega John is to write message & send to 7 churches

V. Illumination of the Vision - 1:12-16

- Son of Man in midst of 7 Lamp-stands 12, 13
 7 Golden Lamp-stands explained in 1:20
 7 churches commissioned to shine for Christ
 In midst of lamp-stands is the Son of Man 13
 Term in Daniel 7:13,14 speaks of Messiah
 Jesus often used this term to refer to Himself
 He is central, has authority over each church– 13
 He is Lord of the church, Head of the church
- John tries to describe the glory of Christ 13-16 His garment – long flowing robe of dignity, honor There is a golden sash around His waist
 - His Hair White, like wool or like snow 1:14 Picture of mature wisdom – cp. Dan. 7:9; 10:5
 - His Eyes As a flame of fire 1:14; Rev. 19:12 Eyes penetrate, burn with perfect discernment With full insight he evaluates, judges churches
 - His Feet Like fine brass, burning in furnace 15 Brass speaks of judgment & justice - Dan. 10:6
 - His Voice Like sound of cascading waters 15 Awesome with great power, majesty, authority
 - He holds 7 stars in His right hand 1:16 1:20 identifies stars as church messengers Right hand, one of power, in complete control
 - Sharp two-edged sword comes out of His mouth His word is authoritative & piercing – Heb. 4:12; Rev. 2:12

His Countenance – As sun in full strength – 16

VI. Impact of the Vision - 1:17-19

- 1. John fell at His feet as dead 1:17 He is in awe before glory of the Exalted Christ Compare Matthew 17:6; Acts 9:3, 4; Isaiah 6:5
- Jesus graciously ministered to him 1:17-18 Put His right hand on him, reassuring him, fear not

He is the first and the last

He is risen from the dead, is alive forever more He has the keys of hell & death – has conquered

3. John is to record what he saw, things that are, things which shall be afterward – 1:19
